



Number of clients who received PrEP services for the first time, and clients who have received services overall in 2021 & 2022



In 2021 & 2022 there was an average of 51.5% of prevented/averted congenital syphilis cases. There were 164 pregnant females under 45 with syphilis in 2021, and 169 in 2022



In 2021 & 2022 there was an average of 7 data projects each year undertaken by STI Control, HIV Prevention, HIV Surveillance, RWPA, RWPB, and Hepatitis C programs.

On average 54.4% of people living with HIV were retained in care

On average 63.2% of people living with HIV were virally suppressed

An average of 66% of patients with early syphilis were treated with BPG within 14 days of specimen collection in 2021 & 2022
