

Annual Integrated Plan 2023 Stoplight Survey



The 2023 annual Integrated Plan Stoplight Survey was open throughout September 2023, wrapping up with 33 responses.

Using the stoplight approach, we asked respondents to rate the 24 objectives, found in the Arizona 2022-2026 HIV/STI/Hep C Integrated Plan, as either RED, YELLOW, or GREEN. Here's our takeaways from the survey.

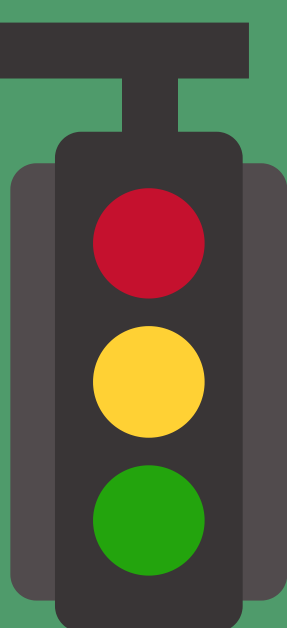

Takeaways

Most objectives were rated as **Yellow**, making limited progress during the first year of evaluation

We expect to see more distinction between **RED** and **GREEN** over the upcoming years (2024-2026)

When asked if any objectives needed rewriting, most respondents answered **no**, but the objectives below stood out with the most votes for improvement



Highest stoplight scores:

- Diagnose – Obj 1-3

Lowest stoplight scores:

- Prevent – Obj 5 & 6

MOST VOTES:

- Diagnose – Obj 2 & 3
- Prevent – Obj 6
- Treat – Obj 5 & 6
- Respond – Obj 5
