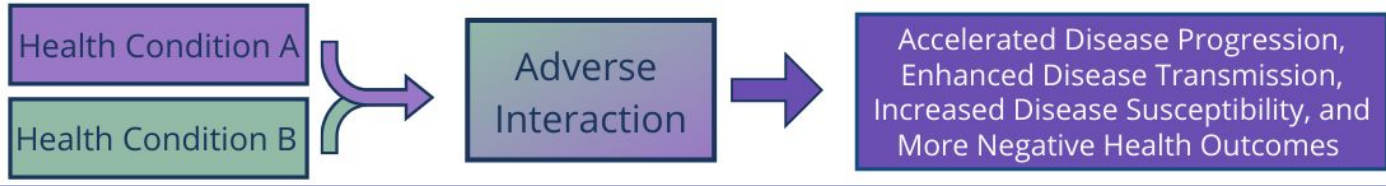


# Arizona 2022-2026 HIV/STI/Hep C Integrated Plan



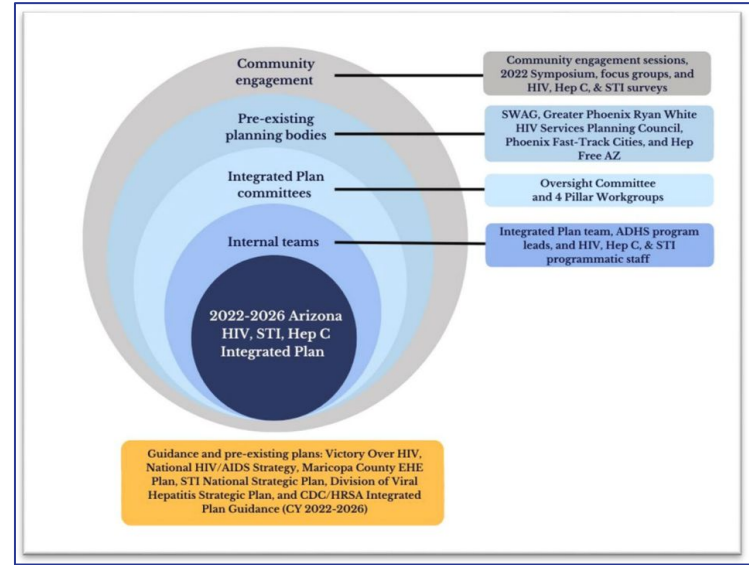
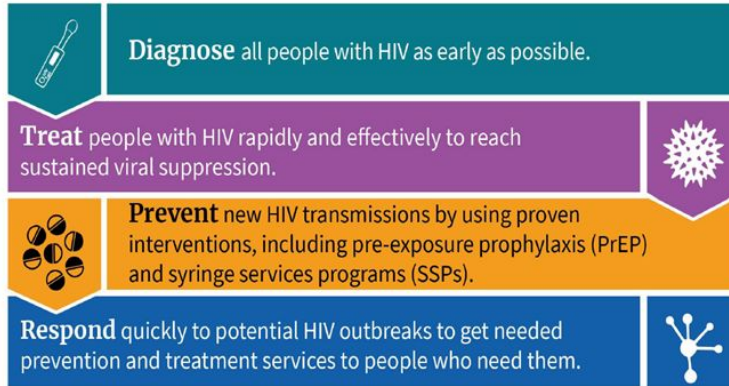
- High-level roadmap for Arizona’s HIV, STI, and hepatitis C programs
- Developed to fulfill federal requirements
- Created for and by those working in and affected by HIV, STIs, and hepatitis C
- “Living document” that continues to be refined

# SYNERGY + EPIDEMIC = SYNDEMIC



## Ending the HIV Epidemic

**75%** reduction in new HIV infections in 5 years and at least **90%** reduction in 10 years.



# Annual Improvement Cycle

## IMPLEMENTATION

Use plan to inform our programs and guidance

## EVALUATION

Survey people throughout the state on “how things are going”

Use results to guide the improvements

## MONITORING

Track annual metrics & outcomes

Develop an annual report

Provide visual graphics of highlighted data points

## IMPROVEMENTS

Select 1-3 objectives to review and edit

Hold sessions for public input on the objectives

## REPORTING & DISSEMINATION

Report out on results and plan improvements

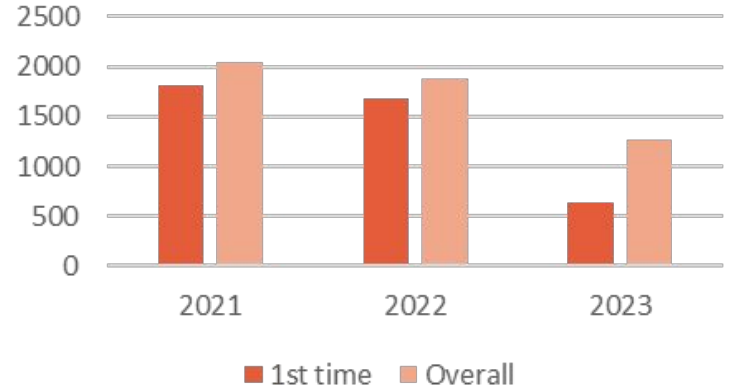
Number of HIV tests reported:

Number of clients who received PrEP navigation services for the **first time**, and the clients who have received services **overall** in 2021, 2022 & 2023

## Treat



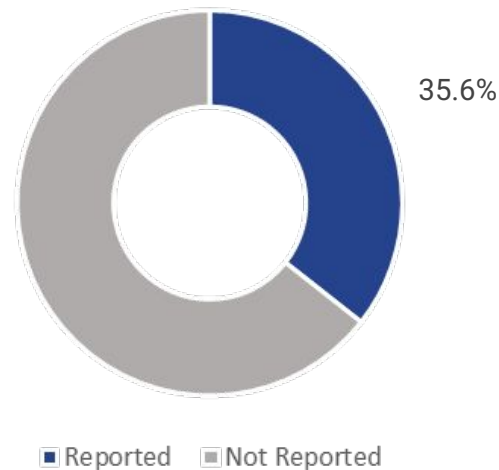
Linkage to care within 1 month of HIV diagnoses

2021: 80.7%

2022: 79%

2023: 79.7%
