Syringe Service Program offering free HIV and HCV prevention supplies including syringes, sterile injection equipment, portable sharps containers, used sharps disposal, smoking supplies, fentanyl test strips, xylazine test strips, condoms, lube, prevention educational materials, overdose prevention education materials, naloxone, and Plan B, wound care and wound care education provided by a nurse, resource referrals, on-site training on how to administer naloxone and radical love for people who use drugs and do sex work.
